

ABOUT OPERATION CHRISTMAS DROP

Operation Christmas Drop is the longest-running humanitarian airlift operation. The tradition began in 1952 when a B-29 Superfortress aircrew saw islanders waving at them from the island of Kapingamarangi, 3,500 miles southwest of Hawaii. In the spirit of Christmas the aircrew dropped a bundle of supplies attached to a parachute to the islanders below, giving the operation its name. Today, air drop operations include more than 50 islands throughout the Pacific. The crews airdrop food, supplies, educational materials and toys to islanders throughout the Commonwealth of the Northern Marianas, Federated States of Micronesia, and Republic of Palau.

Toshikoshi Soba, or Long Life Noodles, is a New Year's tradition in Japan that involves consuming buckwheat noodles on New Year's Eve for good luck.

Originating approximately 800 years ago during the Kamakura period, this practice is believed to have begun at a Buddhist temple where soba was generously distributed to the poor on New Year's Day.

Over time, during the Edo period, the consumption of toshikoshi soba on New Year's Eve evolved into an enduring custom embraced by people throughout Japan, a tradition that continues even today.
